RESOLUTION NO. 2020002
CORPORATE RESOLUTION OF
THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENPOOL, OK
DECLARING A STATE OF EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of Oklahoma has issued a statewide declaration of emergency in response to the COVID-19 outbreak; and

WHEREAS, the United States Center for Disease Control ("CDC") has issued guidelines and directives to assist states, cities and towns in their efforts to minimize the spread of COVID-19, to include increased "social distancing" measures; and

WHEREAS, adoption of measures consistent with these CDC guidelines is necessary to protect the citizens of the City of Glenpool from the community spread of COVID-19.

NOW, THEREFORE, BY VIRTUE OF THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN THE CITY COUNCIL BY THE ELECTORATE OF THE CITY OF GLENPOOL, THE CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES AND STATE LAW, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENPOOL, DOES HEREBY PROCLAIM AND DECLARE:

SECTION ONE: A state of emergency exists within the corporate limits of the City of Glenpool, Oklahoma.

SECTION TWO: This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon execution by the Mayor of the City of Glenpool at an Emergency Meeting convened for that purpose on Tuesday, March 17, 2020 at 6:00 p.m.

SECTION THREE: This Resolution shall and hereby does empower the City Manager of the City of Glenpool, upon verbal notification by the Mayor to do so, to take such additional measures, without limitation and without the necessity of further action by the City Council, as the following:

1. Prohibit the organized gathering of ten (10) or more people, excepting any political or state entities over which the City of Glenpool has no jurisdiction, the City Council and other City Boards, Commission, and Authorities, in or on a City-owned or City operated facility or property until at least April 17, 2020, when the pandemic emergency will be reassessed;
2. Cancel or postpone any scheduled event, and prohibit the scheduling of events, at the City of Glenpool Conference Center;
3. All in-person gatherings for social, spiritual and recreational purposes, including but not limited to community, civic, public, leisure, faith-based, or sporting events, concerts, festivals, conventions, fundraisers, and similar activities are **strongly discouraged**, per CDC recommendations, until the expiration of this emergency declaration.
4. Restaurants, bars, and other privately owned gathering places are **highly encouraged** to ensure at least six (6) feet of space, per CDC recommendations, is available to each patron.
5. Waive the purchasing limit of the City Manager, up to the limits of the Public Competitive Bidding Act.

6. Such other emergency actions as are consistent with the foregoing and with any further public announcements of the federal government, CDC, State government or Tulsa County.

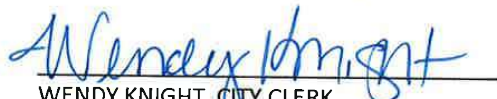
SECTION FOUR: All essential public services, to include utilities and public safety, shall continue without interruption.

SECTION FIVE: This state of emergency shall continue until 12:01 a.m. April 18, 2020 unless terminated earlier, or extended further, by subsequent resolution.

THE FOREGOING RESOLUTION IS HEREBY PASSED AND APPROVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENPOOL THIS 17th DAY OF MARCH 2020.
