

**MINUTES
CITY COUNCIL MEETING
SPECIAL SESSION
November 28, 2016**

The Special Session of the Glenpool City Council was held at Glenpool Conference Center, 1st Floor, 12205 S. Yukon Ave, Glenpool, Oklahoma. Councilors present: Patricia Agee, Councilor; Momodou Ceesay, Vice Mayor; and Timothy Fox, Mayor. Brandon Kearns, Councilor and Jacqueline Triplett-Lund, Councilor were absent.

Staff present: Roger Kolman, City Manager; Lowell Peterson, City Attorney; and Susan White, City Clerk

Also present were Gary Mitchell and Randall Anderson with Kendig Keast Collaborative; Carolyn Back and Jim Beach with Wallace Engineering.

- A) Mayor Fox called the meeting to order at 6:46 p.m.**
- B) The roll was called and Mayor Fox declared a quorum present.**
- C) Scheduled Business**

Mayor Fox declared that the order of the agenda would be modified to proceed with business related to Item 2 then devote the remainder of the meeting to Item 1.

- 1) Community Outreach Workshop, facilitated by Kendig Keast Collaborative for the purpose of soliciting public input into the City of Glenpool Comprehensive Plan revision process.**

Gary Mitchell facilitated discussion among the audience and presented a slide show concerning the Comprehensive Plan revision process.

- 2) Discussion and possible action to authorize payment of delinquent ad valorem tax bills in the amount of \$5,069.37, including principal, interest and penalties, accrued on property located at 14522 S. Broadway, Glenpool, OK, known as the Glenpool Area Emergency Medical Services District ambulance facility, as directed by judgement of the Tulsa County District Court in a certain foreclosure action, such accrued tax bills having been left unpaid by the previous mortgagor of the premises, subject to a lien in favor of mortgagee City of Glenpool, and constituting a senior lien on the premises, which lien the City of Glenpool now wishes to discharge.**

Lowell Peterson, City Attorney recommended Council authorize payment of delinquent ad valorem taxes as part of the foreclosure action to regain ownership of the property located at 14522 S. Broadway, Glenpool, OK.

MOTION: Vice Mayor Ceesay moved, second by Councilor Agee to authorize payment of delinquent ad valorem taxes in the amount of \$5,069.37 accrued on property located at 14522 S/ Broadway, Glenpool, OK, currently known as the GEMS ambulance facility.
