Three Propositions will be on the ballot on April 5th. All three are designed to work together for Glenpool.

Proposition 1

(full project list online at moveglenpoolforward.com)

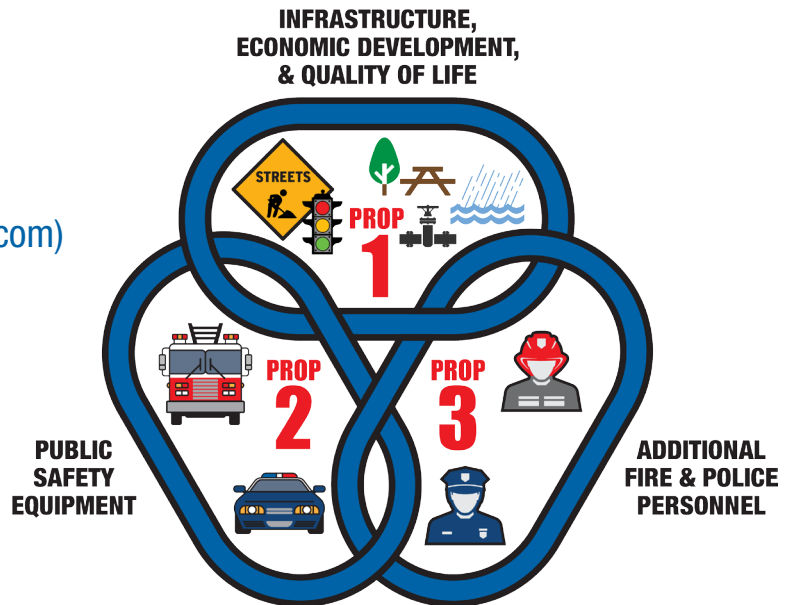
- Sewer infrastructure and storm water management/drainage improvements
- Roadway infrastructure improvements (signalizations at key intersections on City streets, lane widening and improvements on arterial roadways, widening and improving Warrior Road)
- Radio Read Water Meter replacement program for residential meters
- Kendalwood Park playground improvements

Proposition 2

- Replacing and improving key public safety equipment and performing needed public safety capital improvements

Proposition 3

- Adding 5 Police Officers and 7 Firefighters



Propositions 1 and 2, together, are a 20-year extension of the 0.55 of a penny Vision 2025 sales tax originally levied by, and collected by, Tulsa County. These two propositions do NOT raise the sales tax rate in Glenpool. They return local sales tax dollars to local control for use on local projects.

Proposition 3 is a new tax of 0.55 of a penny. It would be dedicated to funding additional police officers and firefighters.

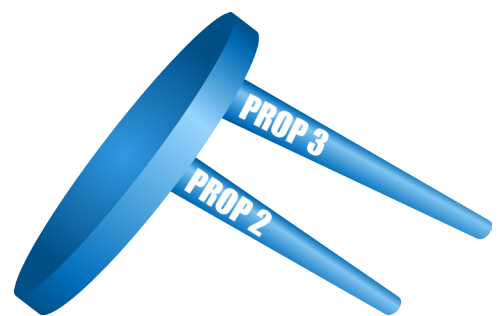
So, what happens if we only address some of the issues now?



Without Proposition 3, we have new fire trucks and police cars, improved communications, and better infrastructure, but inadequate staff levels to ensure public safety or effectively utilize the equipment we've invested in.

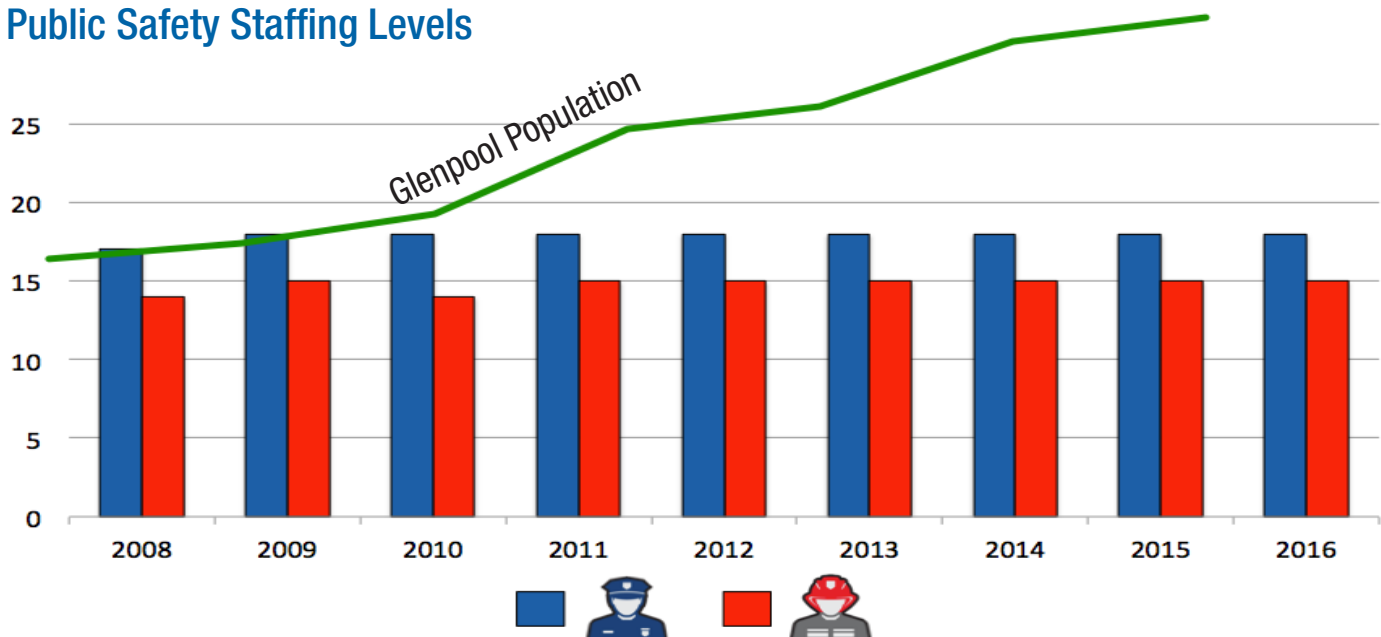


Without Proposition 2, we have additional personnel, but no vehicles or equipment for them to use. We have better infrastructure to attract residents and businesses, but less capacity to keep them safe.



Without Proposition 1, sewer, stormwater, roadway and economic development issues would not be addressed, hampering public safety and other items (pothole and basic street repair, utility upgrades) since necessary work would have to be funded from other sources.

Ambulance Service Provider:

It brings me great pleasure to announce that the Evaluation Committee has selected an ambulance service provider for your recommendation. The members of the Committee dedicated many hours to carefully seeking the best candidate for the District. The Committee utilized a scoring process which eliminated possible bias and established the top two candidates. Both were interviewed, references were checked, and numerous communications were undertaken to determine the best provider for the District. The Ambulance Service Provider selected for recommendation is Mercy Regional EMS.

Mercy will dedicate one, 24-hour 911 ambulance to the District. The response time standard set forth in the agreement remains unchanged from recent agreements with previous providers.

I would like to express my sincere gratitude to EMSA for the extraordinary service they have provided to our citizens since December 2015.

I would also like to applaud the Glenpool First Responders and their families for their dedication and sacrifice while serving the citizens of the GEMS District during these recent months.

Recommendation:

The Evaluation Committee recommends entering into a five-year Agreement with Mercy Regional EMS, effective, date of execution and commencement of services within thirty days.
